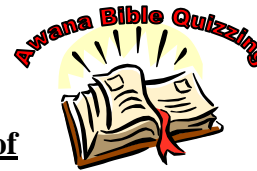

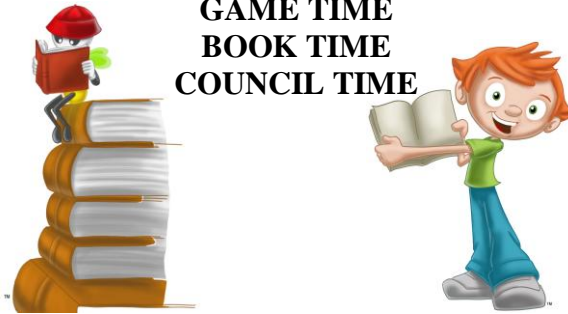

Council Time is a time of singing, sharing together and listening to Bible stories and devotional messages prepared and presented by exemplary leaders.
